OUR STUDENTS Our school is no longer solely composed of students who have been arrested or have a wayward history. True to our mission we continue to serve young people who have struggled academically or who have significant social-emotional needs.

OUR AIM MAPCS students transform risk into resilience enabling them to outpace their peers and improve academically at rates that far exceed their previous pace of learning.

Each year, Maya's CTE students graduate from both the high school and the Young Adult Learning Center

(17+) with certified licenses, career pathways, employable workforce training and interpersonal soft skills

knowing exactly where they will go next after graduation. Under the Maya Angelou Schools' CTE programs for high schoolers and DC residents we offer:

OUR RESULTS

Our educators and administrators are trained in trauma-informed, and restorative justice practices, which is approximately twice the average for public schools in Washington, DC

73% of our graduates enroll in college as compared with approximately 65% of local low-income African-American high school

graduates

In the four years since implementing our Alumni Support program, our graduates' first year persistence in secondary education has increased from 50% to 83%
